1. Art contest is open to all students attending school in Monroe County, Fl., grades Kindergarten through 12th. **LIMIT ONE ENTRY PER PERSON.**
2. **Age Groups** : Grades K-2nd / 3rd to 5th / Middle School / High School
3. **Categories:**
 - a. **Paintings** with medium of choice including acrylics, watercolor, charcoal, pencil, pastels, oil, or mixed.
 - b. **3-D Recycled art** created from actual recycled items such as plastic, bottle caps, trap line, etc.
4. **Artwork Size/Specs: Subject: Sea Turtles**
 - a. Paintings are to be on CANVAS or MOUNTED PAPER with a minimum size of 8"x10" and a maximum size of 11"x14". Canvas must have a wire or hook for hanging. No frames please.
 - b. 3-D Recycled art can be no larger than 24"x24".
5. **SUBMITTING Artwork:**
 - a. **DROP OFF between Nov 15th and Nov 30th, 2023** at Artists in Paradise Gallery located in the Winn Dixie Plaza, Key Deer Blvd., in Big Pine Key or
 - b. **MAIL to SAVE-A-TURTLE** 181 Key Deer Blvd. Box #418, Big Pine Key, Fl 33043. Mailed entries **MUST BE RECEIVED by Nov 30th, 2023.**
6. **JUDGING:**
 - a. Will take place on or about December 8th, 2023, by select artists from Artists in Paradise.
 - b. **PEOPLE'S CHOICE voting** will be online from 12/11/23 – 12/18/23 and advertised on Save-A-Turtle's social media platforms and website.
7. **DISPLAY:** All winning artwork will be on display at Artists in Paradise Gallery in Big Pine Key for the month of January 2024.
8. **PRIZES:** Visa Gift Cards for the following amounts for each age category: 1st Place: \$100. 2nd Place: \$75. 3rd Place: \$50. People's Choice: \$75. 3D Art: \$75. Total prizes awarded: \$1500.
9. **WINNING ARTWORK** may be photographed and printed on merchandise to sell for fund raising for Save-A-Turtle in the Florida Keys (SAT). All winning artwork becomes the property of SAT. All other artworks must be picked up at Artists in Paradise by 2/5/2024. Any unclaimed work will become the property of SAT and may be used for fund raising purposes.

Save-A-Turtle.org (SAT) Art Contest Rules 2023

THE ARTIST

The Competition is open to all students attending school in Monroe County, Fl., Grades Kindergarten (K) to 12th.

AGE GROUPS

There will be four age groups for each category: GRADES K-2ND, 3RD-5TH, Middle School and High School.

THE ART

Art that does not fit within the following Conditions of Entry will not be admissible and will not be considered for the contest. The following are examples (without limitation) of inadmissible works:

Copies of original work

Art that are in breach of copyright or reasonably considered by SAT to create a risk of infringing upon a copyright.

CONTEST THEME is SEA TURTLES

Art must be of a Sea Turtle. Art must be free of any signatures or initials on the front of the art.

CATEGORIES

- **PAINTING** in medium of choice including watercolor, acrylic, oil, pastel, charcoal, ink, pencil, or mixed. Minimum size 8x10," maximum size 11x14" including mat. All paintings must be matted. Framed art will not be accepted. Horizontal or vertical artwork is allowed.
- **3-D RECYCLED ART** project to be made of recycled materials such as plastic, trap line, bottle caps. Etc. Art must not exceed 24x24" overall.

Artwork must be the contestant's original creation; you cannot reproduce another artist's work and present it as your own.

SUBMITTING & DELIVERY of ART

In order to enter the competition, all entrants with parent or guardian's permission, shall complete an application form available at <https://www.save-a-turtle.org/newsandevents.html> and follow all directions therein by attaching to the back of your art. Artwork is to be delivered to Artists In Paradise Gallery located in the Winn Dixie Shopping Plaza on Key Deer Blvd, Big Pine Key, FL between November 15th and 30th, 2023 OR MAILED TO Save-A-Turtle, 181 Key Deer Blvd, Big Pine Key, 33043. Mailed entries must be received by November 30, 2023. Delivery and Collection (and the associated costs and insurance) of the art is the responsibility of the artist.

THE SELECTION PROCESS

The judges shall be appointed by SAT in such number and of such qualification as it sees fit at its sole discretion. The Judge's decision shall be final, and no correspondence will be entered into. All works will be judged anonymously and there will be no segregation by style, etc. Judging will take place on or about December 8, 2023.

PEOPLE'S CHOICE

Each category and age group will also include a **People's Choice Award** whereas the winner will be determined by online voting that will be promoted on Save-A-Turtle's website and social media platforms between 12/11/23 to 12/18/23.

PRIZES

VISA Gift Cards will be awarded as follows for each category and age group:

Paintings: 1st Place: \$100 2nd Place: \$75 3rd Place: \$50 3-D ART: \$75 People's Choice \$75

Total Visa Gift Card amounts to be awarded is \$1500.00.

Save-A-Turtle Art Contest Rules Cont.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND COPYRIGHT

Each artist, by entering the SAT Art Contest confirms that they hold all intellectual property rights in the art. Artists will allow the work to be photographed and reproduced by SAT for the purposes of resale, made into T-Shirts, etc. for fundraising purposes. Copyright remains with the artist. By entering this contest, you are granting Save-A-Turtle the right and license to use the artwork image for their campaign and promotions on any platform for perpetuity. Any inquiries for copyright will be referred to the artist.

DATA PROTECTION

In accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998 (and all other relevant Data Protection legislation), SAT will hold the personal data of artists supplied on the Entry Form securely. The data will only be used in the process of administering the winners and will not be transferred to any third party not directly involved with SAT.

ARTWORK RETURNED

Winning artwork will become the property of Save-A-Turtle. Other artists who would like their artwork returned must include a return package with postage paid. We will not return without total postage paid. It will not be our responsibility to insure it. Artists may also pick up their artwork at Artists in Paradise Gallery by 02/05/24. Any unclaimed artwork becomes the property of Save-A-Turtle.

AGREEMENT TO THE CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Winning artwork will be on display at Artists in Paradise for the month of January 2024. Depending on the number of entries and available space at the gallery, additional works may be displayed as well.

By entering the SAT Art Contest, artists are agreeing to all the within conditions of entry. SAT decision on all matters pertaining to the above is final. SAT reserves the right, at any time, and from time to time to amend, modify, vary, or discontinue the terms of this competition.

Save-A-Turtle has the right to use the name and photo of any contestant and the art image without compensation.

SAT will retain ownership of all winning and unclaimed artworks entered in the contest. In order to promote the SAT organization, products may be produced from artwork images. Any monies made from the sale of the artwork will be used to support SAT's non-profit organization. The winning artists must provide autographs upon request without charging SAT.
